## House Committees

## Dnfluences on LAWMAKING

Exclusive: members may not serve on any other committee (exception Budget)

## Appropriations

Rules
Ways \& Means
Major: members may only serve on one

Nonmajor: members may serve on one major $\&$ one nonmajor committee OR on two nonmajor committees

## Senate Committees

Major: no senator is supposed to serve on more than two - but some do.

Minor: no senator is supposed to serve on more than one - but some do.

Select: ad hoc, temporary bodies

General Accounting Office (GAO)
Congressional Budget Office (CBO)

## The Committee System

- "Gatekeepers" or "Little Legislatures"
- Division of Labor (+5,000 bills/term)
- Oversight of Executive Branch (a check!)
- Seniority System

Majority = Chairman, Minority = Ranking 1970s "Bill of Rights"
(Sub-Committees set agendas)

- House = policy specialists
- Senate = policy generalists
