Political Parties

Institutional Revolutionary Party (PRI)

- Coalition of elites, 1920-2000 (umbrella)
- Accommodation, Corporatism, Patron-Clientalism

National Action Party (PAN)

- Represent business interests & opposed to centralization & anticlericalism (center-right)
- Regional autonomy, free market, fair elections

Democratic Revolutionary Party (PRD)

- Opposition to PRI on the left
- Social justice, populism, difficulty articulating econ policy

Elections - Voting

- PRI small town, rural, less educated, older, poorer
- <u>PAN</u> northern, middle class, professional/business, urban, better educated, more religious
- <u>PRD</u> younger, politically active, central, some education, small town & urban

<u>Media</u>

Past: PRI dominated, media directly subsidized by the govt
